## **Hadley Horn Kits**

## For Vehicles With Air Brakes

- For best results mount horn in an unobstructed opening for sound to carry straight ahead. If possible mount with a slight downward angle to allow moisture to drain from horn.
- 2. If cab is equipped with roof trim panel, remove to install horn.
- 3. Drill  $^{1}/_{2}$ " and  $^{9}/_{32}$ " holes (using gasket for template) in position desired for horn base. Locate positions for front support and drill  $^{9}/_{32}$ " holes.
- **4.** Place gasket between base of horn and top of cab roof, and between support and top of cab roof.
- **5.** Mount horn and support with 1/4" bolts, nuts, and lockwashers.
- **6.** Connect tubing from air supply to horn air inlet.
- **7.** NOTE: Manual valve or electronic solenoid valve must be used to control air supply to horn.

IMPORTANT: Use Pipe Compound on Pipe Threads to Assure Air Tight Connections.

CAUTION: Check local noise abatement ordinances to avoid legal violations.
